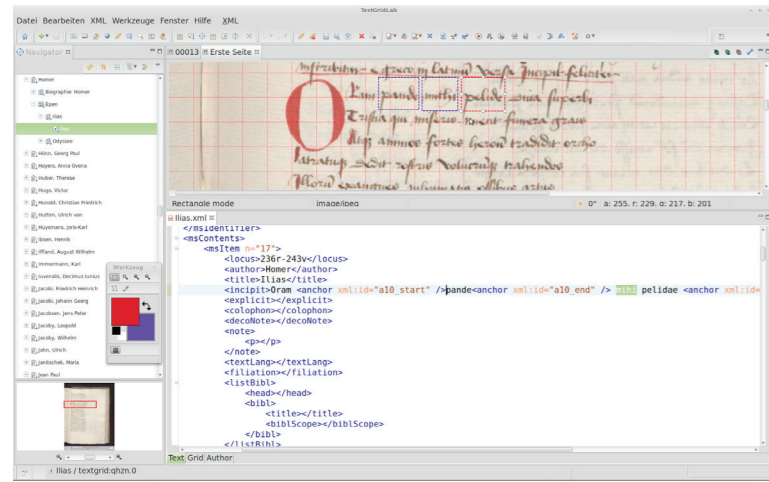

The [TextGrid Laboratory](#) software offers various tools and services to edit, annotate, analyse and visualise digital sources. The Text Image Link Editor, for example, can interlink selections of a digital image, here a facsimile, with the corresponding part of a text file.

About TextGrid

TextGrid – digital editing, research, and archiving

TextGrid is a Virtual Research Environment for scholars in the text-based humanities and cultural studies. Among other features, it supports the creation of digital editions using free and project-specific expandable tools and services. A differentiated user rights management facilitates collaborative work on a shared project in a safe environment. Tools, data and methods can be used mutually, regardless of the operative system, software equipment, or location.

In addition to existing tools and services available in the [TextGrid Laboratory](#) (TextGridLab), the [TextGrid Repository](#) (TextGridRep) provides the user with the

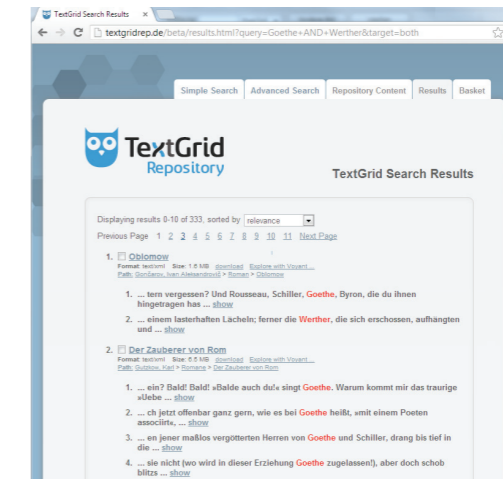
possibility to save, publish, and search a variety of digital resources such as XML/TEI encoded texts, images and databases, and to link them with other portals and archives.

TextGrid facilitates the creation of digital editions, from the provision and creation of primary data in XML to the published and citable research data. Furthermore, it is possible to publish the data in an external online portal or to export it into a print-ready document.

Since 2006, TextGrid has been funded by the German Federal Ministry of Education and Research. Today the TextGrid Laboratory and Repository are used by a number of research projects, including the digital/analog editions “Theodor Fontane’s notebooks” and “Johann Friedrich Blumenbach – online.”
