

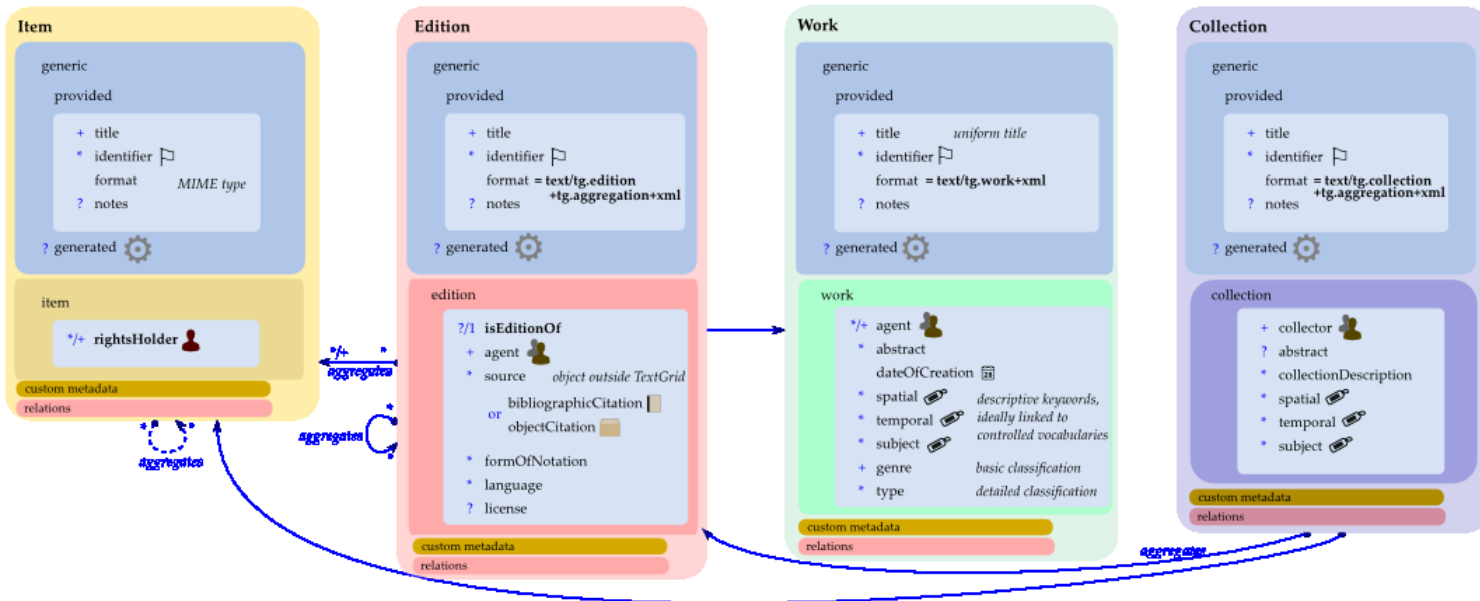

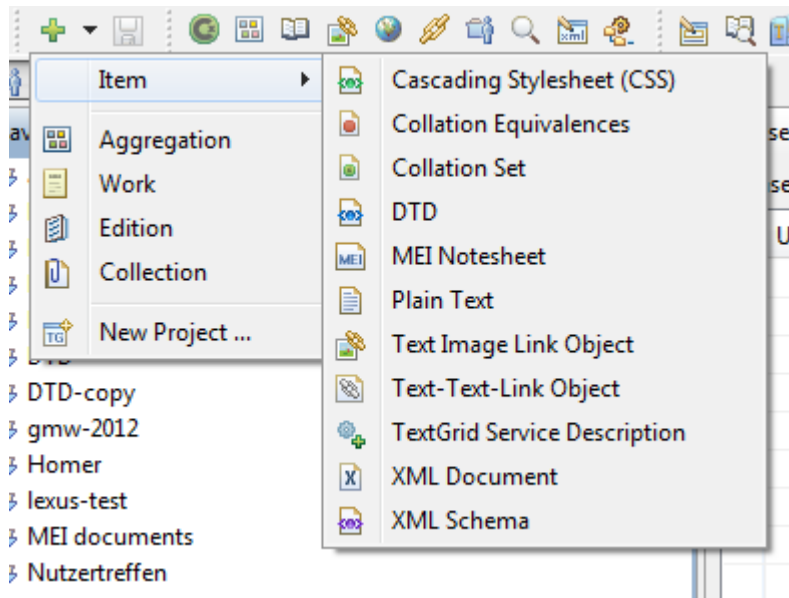

Inhalt + Metadaten + URI

Es werden verschiedene Arten von Objekten unterschieden:

1. Basale Objekte
2. Werke
3. Aggregationen
4. Editionen
5. Kollektionen

**Basale Objekte** sind die einfachsten, nicht zusammengesetzten Objekte in TextGrid.



Beispiele: Transkription und Faksimile

**Werke** sind individuelle Schöpfungen, die in verschiedenen Editionen vorliegen können. Sie bestehen lediglich aus einem Metadatensatz.

# Aggregationen

**Aggregationen** sind TextGrid Objekten, die aus geordneten Listen von Referenzen auf andere TextGrid Objekte bestehen.

Beispiel: *Buch des Sängers*

**Editionen** sind Aggregationen, in denen sich ein Werk manifestiert.

Beispiel: Ausgabe der Werke Goethes

**Kollektionen** sind Aggregationen, die TextGrid Objekte nach einer bestimmten Organisationsform oder thematischen Zugehörigkeit akkumulieren.

Beispiel: Werke des Weimarer Klassizismus

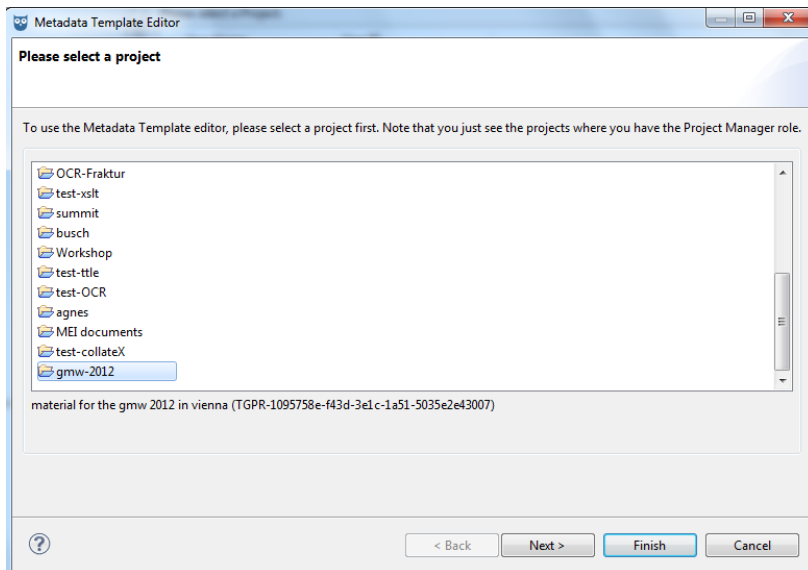

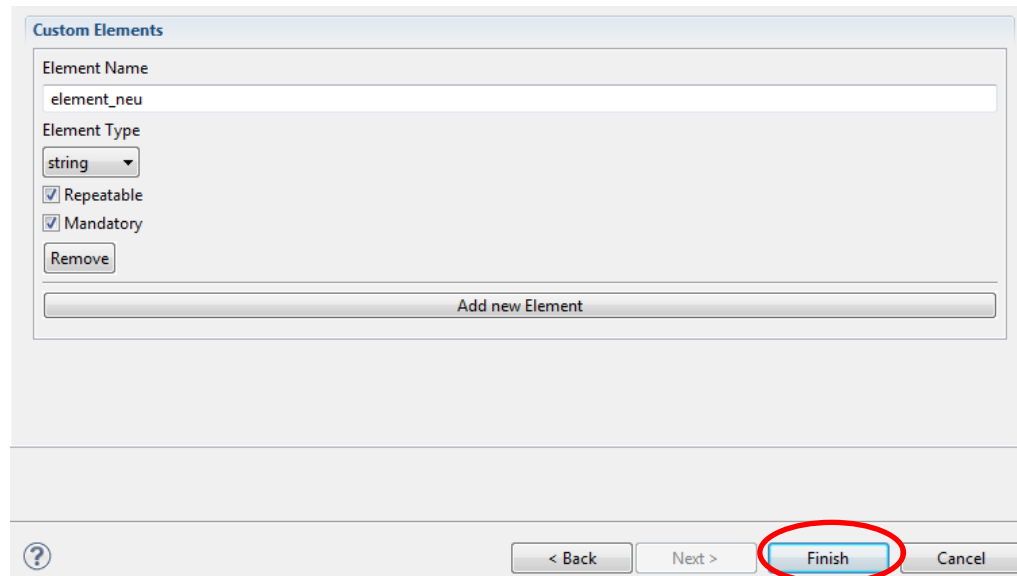

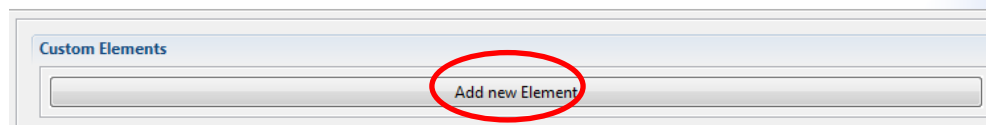
